Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B**

**RESOLUTION #4B-19-0502
Supporting Safety Modifications
for the Intersection of Blair Road and Third Street NW**

Adopted May 20, 2019

Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B (ANC 4B or the Commission) takes note of the following:

- Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) gave written notice on May 6, 2019, of their intent to make modifications at the intersection of Blair Road and Third Street NW [DDOT Notice of Intent #19-120-TOA].
- Following the completion of a safety analysis of Third Street NW and its intersections with Whittier Street NW and Blair Road NW, DDOT intends to clarify operations by installing a flexipost bump-out on the west side of Third Street NW at its intersection with Blair Road NW. This safety modification, however, will also result in the loss of four parking spots on Third Street NW.
- Proposed safety improvements at this intersection received public input and review through ANC 4B’s Public Works and Infrastructure Committee in 2018. DDOT presented to the Committee in a meeting held in March 2018.

RESOLVED:

That Advisory Neighborhood Commission 4B supports DDOT’s planned safety modifications at the intersection of Blair Road and Third Street NW and urges the Department to act expediently to have the improvements installed as soon as practicable.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Commission requests DDOT perform another safety assessment after the modifications have been installed. If the enhancements are found to be an improvement, the Commission encourages DDOT to replace the flexiposts with a permanent bump-out and new curb infrastructure.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the Commission designates Commissioner Geoff Bromaghim, ANC 4B07, to represent the Commission in all matters relating to this resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

That, in the event the designated representative Commissioner cannot carry out his representative duties for any reason, the Commission authorizes the Chair to designate another Commissioner to represent the Commission in all matter relating to this resolution.

FURTHER RESOLVED:

Consistent with DC Code § 1-309, only actions of the full Commission voting in a properly noticed public meeting have standing and carry great weight. The actions, positions and opinions of individual commissioners, insofar as they may be contradictory to or otherwise inconsistent with the expressed position of the full Commission in a properly adopted resolution or letter, have no standing and cannot be considered as in any way associated with the Commission.

ADOPTED by show of hands vote at a regular public meeting (notice of which was properly given, and at which a quorum of seven of nine members was present) on May 20, 2019 by a vote of 7 yes, 0 no, 0 abstain.
